## **NEW KITTENS AND CATS**

## **Feeding**

Depending on age and size

- $\frac{1}{4}$  + 5 oz can ( $\frac{1}{2}$  + 2.5 oz can) ->  $\frac{4x}{day}$  (B, L, D, Bedtime)
- 1/8 c. dry for overnight (also stops the 4 am "Feed Me!" antics)
- Fresh, clean water every day or more, depending on its condition
- NO SEAFOOD UNTIL KITTEN IS 6 MONTHS LD-> They can become very picky eaters, costing you a lot of money
- Food bowls must be wide and shallow to prevent Whisker Fatigue

Suggested Food: Royal Canin's Mother and Baby Cat (canned and dry) until 5-6 months

Any good canned and dry kitten after that Alternate with First Mate canned chicken and turkey

Acana beef canned

## **Litter Boxes**

- Basic Rule- 1 box/cat +1
- Suggested Litter- Odour Buster
- Clean every day
- NEVER use scented litter-> cats hate it (smell is far too strong)

## **Introductions to Household and Other Pets**

**Household:** First, introduce to household slowly by having a room for the kitten/cat for a few days. Then, let out in increasing amount of time to let him/her investigate and get familiar with the place.

**Pets:** Follow the directions given by Jackson Galaxy on YouTube. Basically, it's gradual introductions through supervised steps: 1) Sells and scent exchanges 2) Using carriers to start and then switching off 3) No carriers but supervised
